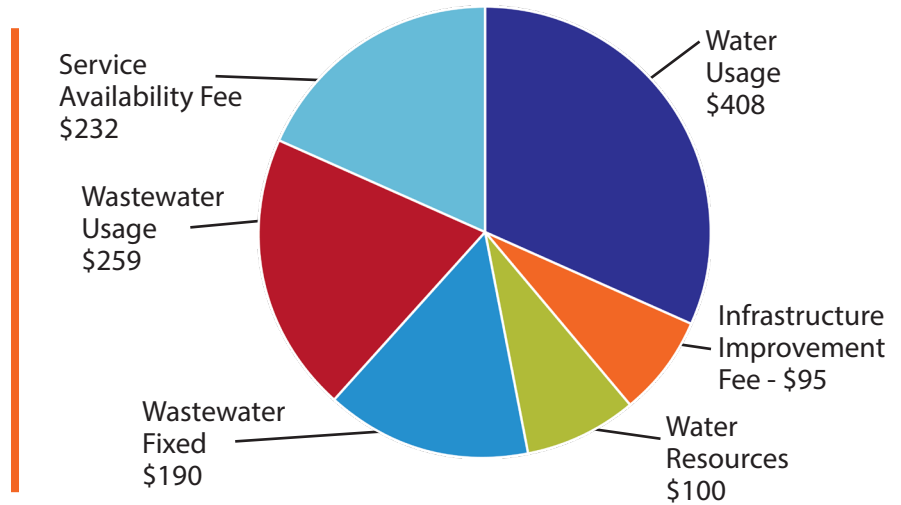
## New rates proposed starting in January 2025

In January 2025, residential customers will see a moderate rate increase on their water and wastewater bill. This increase is in line with projections reported in our 2024 adopted budget and is part of our broader strategy to ensure we continue to meet service demands, maintain infrastructure, and improve water delivery systems.

### What do water rates pay for?

Water rates cover more than just the cost of delivering water; they fund the infrastructure required to provide safe, clean, and reliable water. This includes maintaining pipes, treatment facilities, and conducting quality testing. Additionally, water rates support essential operations, long-term planning, and improvements to ensure the water system's resilience in the future.

Centennial Water has one of the lowest rates in our region. The estimated annual water and wastewater bill for a typical single family residence will be **\$1,285**.

### Budget process and timeline

Rates and fees are reviewed during the budget process and a public hearing on the budget and rates is held at the November board meeting. New rates generally go into effect the first billing period after Jan. 1.
